Main target groups

CSOs, housing managers, housing owners' associations (HOAs), builders, planners, energy auditors, local and national authorities responsible for housing, modernisation of buildings and energy efficiency

Achievements to date

- 154 participants (95 w / 59 m) from CSOs and other spheres improved their knowledge on the topics of sustainable housing, energy-saving modernisation of MFHs. 25 webinars were held.
- Improved interaction between CSOs and LAs to improve local housing modernisation programmes – Akimats of project partner cities and additionally Kokshetau are forming groups to work on the Roadmap for practical implementation of energy saving measures in the modernisation of MFHs.
- 27 events (conferences, round tables, consultations between CSOs and national and local authorities); 588 participants (334 w / 254 m).
