### Project Description

The project aims to strengthen the capacity of civil society organisations (CSOs) to enhance their participation in decision-making to support the development of sustainable housing in three target cities – Astana, Almaty, Petropavlovsk.

The project will build the capacity of local CSOs to critically evaluate the programmes for the refurbishment of multi-family houses (MFHs) and develop concepts for the implementation of energy-efficient refurbishment of the housing stock.

### Main target groups

CSOs, housing managers, housing owners' associations (HOAs), builders, planners, energy auditors, local and national authorities responsible for housing, modernisation of buildings / multi-family houses (MFHs) and energy efficiency.

### Achievements to date

- 250 participants (163 w / 87 m) from CSOs and other spheres improved their knowledge on the topics of sustainable housing, energy-efficient modernisation of MFHs. 25 webinars were held.
- Preparation of the report "Assessment of the results of the modernisation of the housing stock of the Republic of Kazakhstan".
- A Roadmap (RM) has been developed for decarbonising the building sector, with a focus on the residential stock of the Republic of Kazakhstan:
  - collaboration with the German Energy Agency (dena);
  - development of the RM was accompanied by the following events: 5 webinars, 2 seminars, 1 study tour to Lithuania on the topic of energy efficiency in buildings;
  - see the project website, sections "News" and "Library, Project Documents".
- A competition for CSOs has been developed and announced, aimed at promoting the sustainable development of the MFHs stock. The winners will be announced in February 2026.
